The governing board has a vacancy for an LA (Local Authority) Governor (definition of a Local Authority: Local Authority governors are nominated by the local authority (LA). They serve as the link between the LA and the school but aren't political appointees.) and is looking for a self-motivated individual, who cares passionately about the school. Previous experience as a governor is useful but not essential (training can be arranged).

The Board has three strategic core functions of which the successful candidate will play a role in maintaining:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- Holding executive leaders to account for the educational performance of the organisation and its pupils, and the performance management of staff; and
- Overseeing the financial performance of the organisation and making sure its money is well spent.

The Board has planned meetings 6 times per academic year; meetings are usually held at 5.30pm on a Monday at the school.
